NEW HIRE, PATROLMAN/POLICE OFFICER

Resolution #120 – 2018

As appointed by Deputy Mayor Devlin, on motion by Trustee Holderied, seconded by Trustee Monroe, the Board duly resolved as follows:-

To approve the hire of Jesse P. Summo as Patrolman/Police Officer pending the results of his pre-employment drug test, as of Monday, June 4, 2018 at the current union negotiated rate.

At the previous meeting the Board included in a resolution to have new Police Department hires sign a document acknowledging that if they leave Village employment within three years of finishing the Police Academy, they or their new employer will be required to reimburse the Village the prorated cost of the academy based on length of employment. Board has been advised by counsel that such an agreement would have to be approved by the Police Union. In the meantime, it will be discussed with the Chief whether the new recruits can be made aware of the state law that any agency hiring a new police officer within three years of them graduating the academy is required to reimburse the agency they are hiring the officer from for a pro-rated portion of the academy cost.

With no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Trustee Monroe, seconded by Trustee Holderied and the meeting was unanimously adjourned at 9:10 am.
